Where do top movies (*movie* is the American English equivalent for *film*) like *X-Men* and *Pirates of the Caribbean* come from? They almost always come from Hollywood – the film capital of the USA. Hollywood's movie studios make about 500 films a year and they make all kinds of films, from westerns and war films to fantasy and animated. It's easy to see a film in Hollywood; there are several movie theatres on Hollywood Boulevard, for example the Kodak Theatre, which is home to the Academy Awards ceremony. But it's difficult to find a famous actor in Hollywood because movie stars don't live there. They often have a very large house in Beverly Hills, which is about 3km away.



On the other side of the world, Mumbai is India's film capital. The Indian film industry, or 'Bollywood', makes about 1,000 films a year and about 14 million people go to the cinema to watch these films every day in India. The nickname **Bollywood** comes from the city of



Bombay (which is now called Mumbai) and Hollywood. Bollywood films are usually musicals with a lot of dancing and romance. They are usually comedies about a boy who falls in love with a girl but their families aren't happy.


