Hello! I'm Harry. I live in England with my mum, dad and little sister, Rosa.

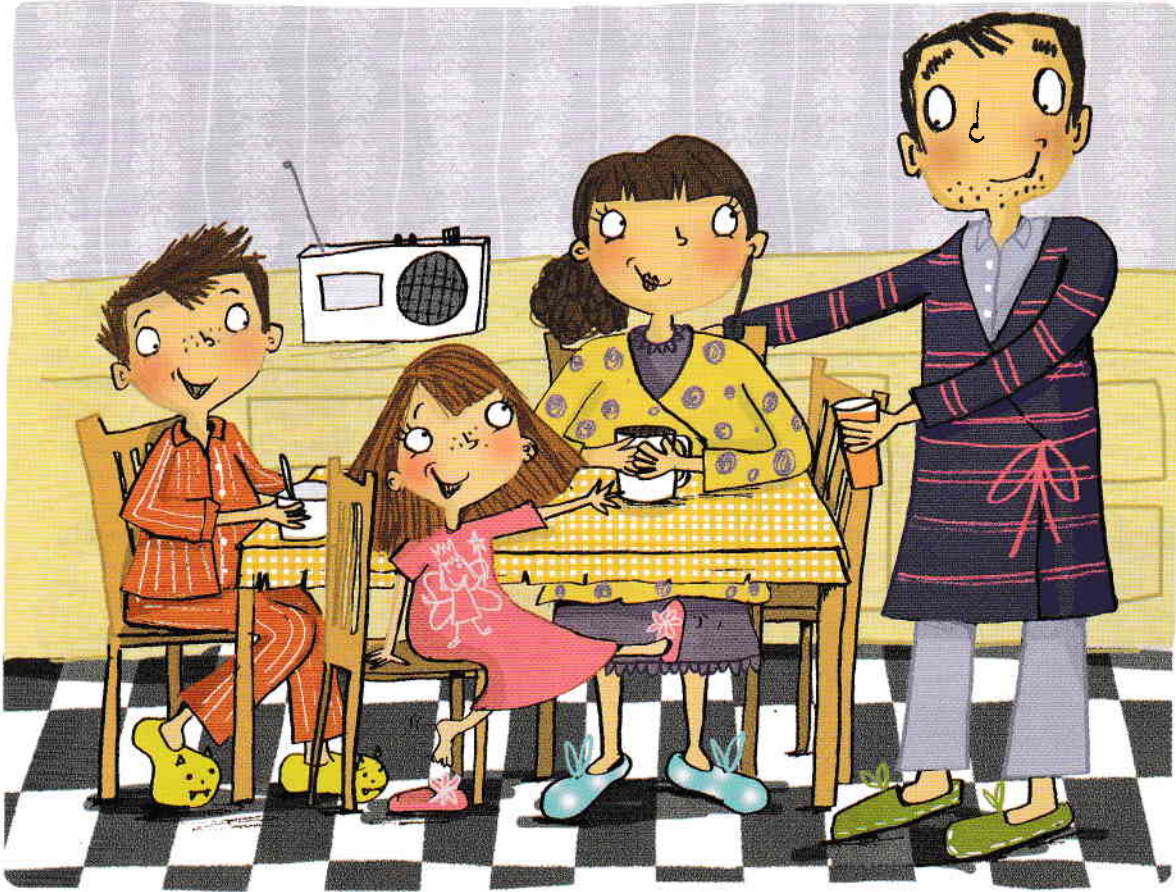
Last month at school, we did a project about clothes. At first, I said to my teacher, 'But! I don't know *anything* about clothes!'



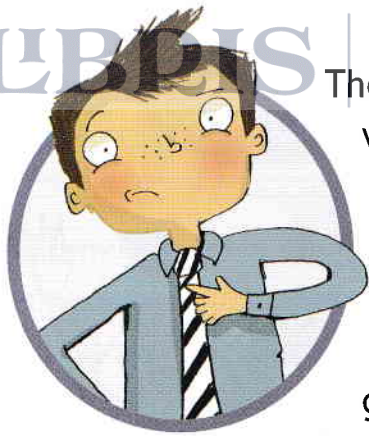
