PEER PRESSURE

Peer pressure happens when people around you try to make you act differently. Your friends and other people your age can influence what you say or do. Sometimes, you might feel you must be like them to fit in. People often change their behaviour because they want others to accept them. Your classmates might encourage you to skip class or break some school rules. You could feel forced to wear certain clothes just to be cool. Peer pressure is not always negative, as it can also push you toward good things. Your friends might inspire you to study harder for better grades. They could encourage you to join sports teams or try new healthy activities.

Teenagers usually feel peer pressure more strongly than other age groups do. Young people care a lot about what their friends think of them. They want to belong to groups and feel accepted by others. It is important to know how to handle peer pressure in healthy ways. You should learn to say “no” when you feel uncomfortable about something. Good friends will respect your choices and not force you to change. Talking to parents or teachers can help when peer pressure becomes too much. They can give you advice about making good choices for yourself.

Remember that your opinions and feelings matter more than others’ expectations. You can stay true to yourself while still having friends and being social. Choose friends who share your values and respect your decisions. Real friendship means accepting each other without forcing changes.
